

## SKYWARN Activation Net

Is the frequency in use? *(Let repeater drop)*

Is there any Emergency or Priority traffic? *(Handle traffic or acknowledge nothing heard) (If nothing heard)*

Hearing nothing, this is *Callsign* My name is *Name*, I am currently located in the city of *Location*, Georgia. I will be your net control station for this Skywarn net.

The reason for this net is because The National Weather Service in Peachtree City has placed *Banks and/or Jackson County* under a: *State Reason*. This net is to provide weather spotting and situational awareness for the National Weather Service and the local EMAs. *(Let repeater drop)*

Will anyone volunteer to be Alternate Net Control? *(Let repeater drop)*

Is the Jackson County EC, KC4RSL, on the frequency? *(Let repeater drop)* Are you aware of our Activation?

Is the Banks County EC, KE4IGD, on the frequency? *(Let repeater drop)* Are you aware of our Activation?

Is there a station who can volunteer as our Satellite Imagery Officer (SIO)? *Acknowledge the station.*

Is there a station who can volunteer as our Warnings and Bulletins Officer (WBO)? *Acknowledge the station.*

Is there a station who can volunteer as or State SKYWARN Relay Officer (RO)? *Acknowledge the station.*

Our primary operations net will be held the 147.225 Mhz/+ NE4GA repeater in Commerce Georgia. Please note that this repeater uses a PL tone of 123.0. If the Northeast Georgia Amateur Radio Club repeater is not available then the net will be called on the Tri-County WX4TC repeater which is 145.310 Negative Offset and a PL Tone of 123.0. *Our simplex operations net will be held on 145.000 MHz simplex.*

Before I take check-ins, Is there any Emergency or Priority traffic? *(Handle traffic or acknowledge nothing heard) (If nothing heard)* Any Relays? *(Handle traffic or acknowledge nothing heard)* When checking in, please slowly state your call sign phonetically, regularly, state your name, and your current location. Any SKYWARN member wishing to check in - please call net control, now. *(Take check-ins)*

Any stations with reportable criteria (Hail, ½ inch in diameter or larger, Wind speeds greater than 40 mph, Cloud features suggesting storm organization) please call net control now. *(Handle traffic or acknowledge nothing heard) (If nothing heard)* Any Relays? *(Handle traffic or acknowledge nothing heard)*

This is *callsign*, Net Control, All stations stand by for a *(message / Severe Weather Statement)*. From the National Weather Service in Peachtree City Ga. At *Give Time on message, A ???? Severe thunderstorm, Tornado Warning, etc..... End of Message. Does anyone need any fills on that last message? (If nothing heard – Any Relays?)*

We will now conduct a roll call. *Call for stations that have checked in. You may want to have stations report conditions at their locations when checking in.*

We will now take additional check ins, again - please slowly state your callsign phonetically, your name, your current location, Anyone, anywhere that has not already checked in - wishing to check in please call *callsign*, net control, now.  
*(Take check-ins)*

I would like to thank everyone for their service during this SKYWARN Activation. I would also like to thank The Northeast Georgia Amateur Radio Club or *TriCounty Amateur Radio Club* for allowing us the use of the repeater. I would like to also thank all our Mutual Aid Partners for assisting us. This is *callsign* now closing the NEGARC SKYWARN Net at *local time 24hr format*, and returning the (repeater or *frequency*) back to its' normal operating use.
